

## Instructions for authors:

1. MFIS2020 is targeted to showcase high quality research work from prospective researchers around the globe. Manuscripts are invited which are not submitted or under consideration in any other venue (journal, workshop, seminar or conference).
2. Manuscripts should be 4-6 pages in length in the prescribed format as specified in the website of the conference. Manuscripts below 4 pages or exceeding 6 pages will be summarily rejected without review.
3. The submission of manuscripts should be done through EasyChair Conference Management System, through the link provided in the conference website. No submission through email communication will be reviewed.
4. The figure resolutions used in the manuscript should be above 200 DPI.
5. Authors are requested to submit their paper under a track. However, it will be sole discretion of the Technical Program Committee to change the track, if applicable, based on the technical area that has been highlighted in the manuscript.
6. Each paper will be reviewed by two independent experts. The final decision of acceptance, rejection will be solely based on technical quality of the manuscript, and decided by the Technical Program Committee. After the publication of List of final accepted papers, no further communication will be entertained on rejected manuscripts. However, the authors of rejected manuscripts will be communicated with the review comments, which they may consider for further improvement of the work and submit in a different venue.
7. At least one author of each accepted and registered paper in MFIS2020 should be presented for its inclusion in the IET Digital Library, subject to the post conference quality check of the manuscripts.
8. A submitted manuscript will be considered under 'Student Paper' category only if all authors are students (UG,PG or PhD). Post doctoral students or associates are excluded from this category. For such accepted and registered papers, the presenter has to provide documentary evidence of his/ her studentship at the conference venue, failing which, the full registration category will be applicable. It may kindly be noted that, the conference will arrange special student sessions to showcase all student papers in each track.
9. If an author submits multiple manuscripts, on acceptance of these, each paper should be separately registered for oral presentation.
10. Author of an accepted and registered manuscript can withdraw his paper before the proceedings preparation. The registration fees is non refundable after the proceedings of the conference has been prepared.
